Russell and Carla Frazier have served as Global Missionaries in Nairobi, Kenya, living on the campus of Africa Nazarene University for the past eight years. Russ is a senior lecturer and Dean of the ANU School of Religion and Christian Ministry, and Carla is an assistant in the finance department.

Previously, the Fraziers served in pastoral ministry in the United States for over 20 years. From 1998 to 2005, they served as missionaries in Kigali, Rwanda. Their ministry extended to the Great Lakes region of Africa, including Rwanda, the Democratic Republic of the Congo, and Burundi. At that time, Carla administered the Child Sponsorship program and assisted in the administration of the Bible institute. Russ served as the coordinator of theological education, coordinator of Nazarene Literature, district superintendent, mission coordinator, and assistant to the Field Strategy Coordinator.

Currently, Russ is working with the Africa Region of the Church of the Nazarene to establish a new institution (Faculté de théologie de l'Église du Nazaréen or FATEN). It is designed to offer a bachelor's degree to French-speaking pastors – it will be the first of its kind in the world for the Church of the Nazarene!
